General contractual representations and warranties by the competitors and riders (competitors and riders = participants)

The participants shall be held jointly and severally liable for all their obligations under the entry contract.

The participants warrant and declare that

- the information provided in this entry form is complete and correct;
- they are fully fit to meet the requirements of the event (= timed and un-timed practices, qualifying practices, warm-ups, races, speed tests);
- the boat/jetboat complies in all respects with the applicable Technical Regulations;
- the boat/jetboat, including all of its parts, can be examined by the Scrutineers at any time;
- at the event concerned, they shall use the boat/jetboat only in technically and visually faultless condition.

By signing this document, they further declare that they have read and understood the International Sporting Code (ISC) of the U.I.M. (Union Internationale Motonautique), the IJSBA (International Jet Sports Boating Association) ISC and its appendices, the UIM legal and disciplinary provisions, the international and national anti-doping regulations (WADA/NADA Codes), the applicable DMYV and DJSV Rules and Regulations, the general championship provisions and the special series provisions, the DMYV and DJSV environmental guidelines and any other UIM, IJSBA, DMYV, DJSV and they agree to be bound by and comply with them.

More specifically, the participants recognise the following as binding:

- they shall assume responsibility for and be held responsible for any facts relating to the person or behaviour of their team members (competitors, drivers, mechanics, assistants etc.) and reflecting on their contractual relationship with the event host or giving grounds for claims for damages;
- always within the scope of their respective competences, the UIM, the IJSBA, the DMYV, the DJSV, its courts, the stewards, and the event hosts shall be authorised to hand down penalties for violations of any sporting rules and laws as well as contractual obligations – as laid down in the ISC, the Rules and Regulations, Event Hosts' Supplementary Regulations, and other rules and regulations – or take any other action. Their right to pursue the federation's legal process laid down in the ISC and Rules & Regulations shall not be affected by prior options;
- they shall not use any banned substances or methods as defined in the WADA World Anti-Doping Code and in the UIM/IJSBA anti-doping regulations.

Authorisation to Lodge Protests and Appeals

By submitting their entry, the participants (including several drivers entered for one boat/jetboat) authorise each other to represent one another in protest or appeal procedures. More specifically, they authorise each other to submit, withdraw, announce, lodge and confirm protests, to withdraw and renounce appeals, and to submit all kinds of requests allowed in the protest and appeal procedures, as well as to submit and/or accept any declarations.

Participants' Release and Waiver of Liability

The participants shall take part in the event at their own risk. They bear the sole responsibility under civil and criminal law for any damage or injury caused by them.

They hereby release the entities and persons listed below from any liability for damages in connection with the event:

- their own entrants/competitors (side agreements between the participants to any other effect shall take precedence!) and assistants,
- the other participants, the owners of the boats/jetboat used in the event (if the event takes place on a permanent or temporarily closed race course), and their assistants,
- the UIM, the IJSBA, DMYV, DJSV, the membership organisations of the DMYV and the DJSV, their presidents, governing bodies, managers and secretaries-general, staff and members,
- the promoter/series organiser,

- the event host, the officials, the race course owners, government agencies (or their respective legal entities), racing services and any other person involved in the organisation of an event,
- the organisation responsible for the construction and maintenance of the waterways, where damage is caused by the condition of the waterways (including waterway furniture) used during the meeting and
- the agents and workers, legal representatives, salaried staff and volunteers of all persons and authorities indicated above as well as their members.

This waiver shall not include damage or harm to life, body or health or any other damage resulting from the intentional or grossly negligent breach of duty nor any damage resulting from material breach by the group of persons released from liability. The liability for financial loss and loss of property in claims resulting from the slightly negligent breach of material obligations shall be limited to the extent of the foreseeable damage as is typical for this type of agreement.

The waiver of liability shall thus apply to claims for any legal reason whatsoever, including but not limited to claims for damages based on contractual and non-contractual liability and to claims from tortious liability.

Any implied waivers of liability shall remain unaffected by the above Release and Waiver of Liability.

By submitting their entry, the participants acknowledge that boat or jetboat insurance (accident insurance) does not cover damage or claims incurred during a meeting aiming to achieve top speeds. They undertake to pass this information on to the owner of the boat/jetboat used.

Should any injury occur or be discovered during a meeting or should health impairments temporarily or permanently jeopardise the ability to operate a motorboat/jetboat – considering the safety risks this may pose not only to the undersigned themselves, but also to third parties – the undersigned releases all attending physicians from confidentiality with respect to each other and with respect to the Clerk of the Course, the Steward of the Meeting, the Chief Medical Officer, the DMYV rescue team, the DJSV jetboat- marshals, the DMYV, and the insurance claims department.
